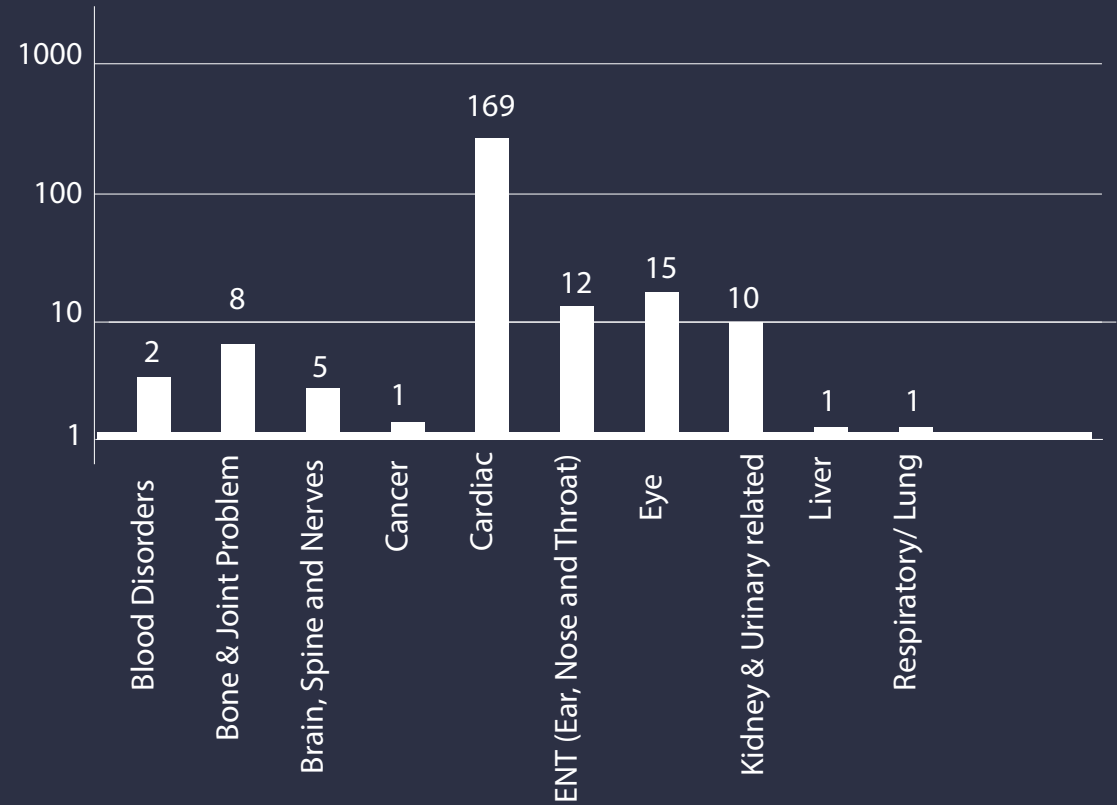

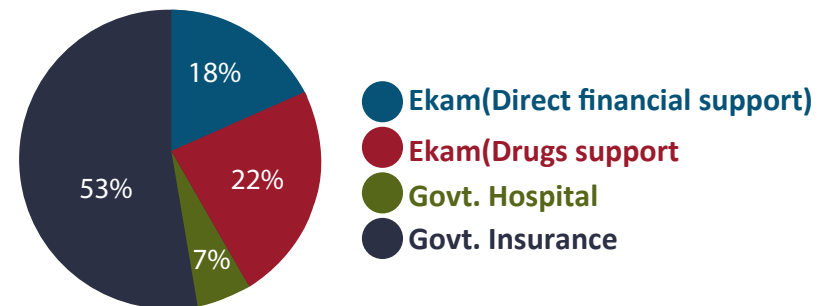

DENGUE AWARENESS PROGRAMME

In this quarter we have conducted Dengue awareness program with the help of School and College volunteers. We have carried out cleaning activities, distributed Nelavembu Kasayam & Papaya leaf extract in schools, college and for general people.



DAAN UTSAV 2017

Every year in the month of October we will celebrate Joy of giving week (Daan Utsav). This year have celebrated from 2nd to 8th Oct 17 by conducting Awareness programmes, Kitchen Garden & Cleaning activities at hospitals with help of ICDS Teachers, School & College volunteers, Nehru Yuva Kendra and general public. Around 14,183 persons had been benefited out of trainings in all 32 districts of Tamilnadu.

MCH TRAINING PROGRAM:

In this quarter we have conducted the Maternal Child Health Training programs to ANC Mothers, ICDS Teachers, College Students, School Children, Nehru Yuva Kendra and general people during the Training we are covered the topics is Govt Schemes – 108, 104, CM Insurance Schemes, Food & Nutrition, Kitchen Garden. Altogether 6965 persons have attended and benefited from 136 Trainings from 28 districts in Tamilnadu.



MEDICAL CAMPS

In this quarter we have conducted medical camps in the below Localities:

* We have conducted Medical camp in Perambalur Govt Hospital on 5th October 2017. Children screening was conducted by Apollo Team from Chennai. Totally 20 Babies have been screened. 5 babies were identified to have serious abnormalities and 3 babies were identified that to require immediate surgical intervention.

* We have conducted the Medical camp (General & Eye) in East Namachivayapuram community in Choolaimedu, Chennai. 135 people benefited to general camp and 65 people benefited to eye camp.

* We have conducted the Cardio Referral follow up camp in GH, Perambalur district 18th Nov 2017. Children Screened by Dr. Arul & Global Team in Chennai. Altogether 75 Babies participated out of it 15 babies Identified with illness.

* We have conducted the Cardiac referral follow up camp in Nilgiri district. This program is supported by DEIC and Prem social worker, Ooty. Patients are covered in gudalur and ooty block. Totally 120 patients have participated and 15 children were identified & informed to seek immediate surgical intervention.

* We have conducted the Cardio Referral follow up camp in GH, Ariyalur district 25th Nov 2017. The children were screened by Dr.Arul & Team from Global Hospital, Chennai. Altogether 154 Babies participated out of it 24 babies Identified.

* As a next step we have conducted the Referrals follow up Cardiology Screening Medical camp on 22nd December 2017 at Thanjavur Corporation Higher Secondary School in Thanjavur District. We are screened the 66 Babies with the support of medical team from Global Hospital, Chennai. Finally 29 Babies are identified with heart disease.



FARMERS TRAINING:

In October month we have conducted the Shivyog Farming meditation program to Farmers. Around 275 members in 6 districts in Tamil Nadu like Madurai, Virudhunagar, Tanjore, Villupuram, Salem and Thiruvallur. Farmers eagerly participated and got motivated through this programme.

In December we have conducted the training program to the farmers in Virudhunagar & Nilagiri district in Tamilnadu. During this training we have covered topics like natural farming, Shivyog, bore well system and the procedure for saving water. This effective training is given by Mr.Kannan, Farming Consultant.We are so happy with the outcome of this program.

LIVELIHOOD PROJECT:

In this quarter Our District Coordinators have collected the 40 organic formers database in 9 districts in Tamilnadu. This is done with the intension of giving encouragement and guidance to the Farmers. Since this is in the progress, we will catch you all with the rest of the information in our next newsletter.

The scheduled Maternal Child Health Awareness Training (includes Antenatal Care, Postnatal care, Care of newborn and essential home based newborn care and Child healthcare) for Pregnant women & Mothers was held from 4th December 2017 to 9th December 2017 for first 3 days at SM Nagar, S. Boag road slum tenement and next 3 days at Kamarajar Colony slum tenement. As a result of this training around 250 Mothers & their children got benefited by understanding the importance of Maternal & Child Health.

CARITAS – UDHYAM ECO DRR PROJECT

In this month, our District officers of Caritas Project areas had meeting with Chengalpattu Rural Development Society with Women Groups leaders for Caritas Udhyam Project updates on 5th Oct 2017. During the meeting they had brain storming sessions and devised plans for health teaching, environmental sanitation & dengue awareness in project areas.

We were conducted the MCH Training program given to SHG members Training we are covered the topics is Govt Schemes – 108, 104, CM Insurance Schemes, Food & Nutrition, Kitchen Garden around 404 persons are attended, with support of Chengalpattu, Vellore, Dharmapuri Social Service society in Tamilnadu.
