BABY OF **HEMALATHA**

Baby of Hemalatha, preterm, was in NICU Rangadore hospital for a month discharged by the end of Sep 2017. The parents are farmers and they were profusely thanking Ekam for the support. Today the baby is healthy and active. The doctors are happy with her growth.

BABY **SHREYAS**

Shreyas is a 7 month old child who is growing well and is neurologically normal. He is the first born to parents who are farmers. This child was born normally but had a abnormal connection between his trachea and esophagus as a new born. He was in the NICU for a period of two weeks , and needed two surgeries during this period. The first one to correct the abnormal connection ,second to correct the perforation in the stomach as a result of the abnormal connection.He came to the PICU for a duration of 1 month in the month of February , where in he needed ventilation for 3 weeks and 2 surgeries.

The surgery this time was to reduce the aspiration of food from the stomach . The surgical correction gave way secondary to his malnutrition. The bill for this admission was over 2.5 lakhs. The hospital waived off 50,000 in addition to doing both the surgeries for free. He was again hospitalised in the PICU for 5 days about 2 months back. This time again the hospital tried to help the family by charging ward charges even though the patient was in the ICU .During his last hospitalization NTT Data helped by paying for his treatment. The child is growing well and is continuing to do well since his discharge. We have seen him on a follow up twice since discharge. We sincerely appreciate your help for the care of this precious child.



BABY OF **SHASHIKALA**

Baby of Shashikala, preterm, was in NICU Rangadore for a month and got discharged in Nov 2017. The baby is growing fine and Healthy and is getting checkedup regularly. Doctors are happy with his growth. The parents were very happy to hear form Ekam and showered their blessings on Ekam team.
